Our work in Peru began in July of 2005. We fly into Lima, then to Pucallpa.

From there we drive 4x4 trucks to either the city of Breu or Puerto Bermudez. The drive is around 8 hours,



but on the way back we charter a float plane from Puerto Bermudez, or a 6 passenger Cessna from Breu, for a one hour flight back to Pucallpa.

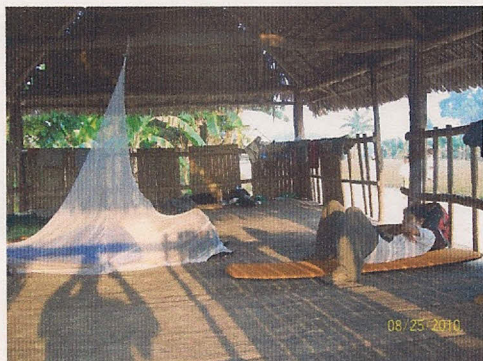


In the villages there is not electricity, and in many cases we utilize boats for transportation.

Many of the houses in this area are platform houses made from bamboo with thatch roofs. We sleep in one of these houses in sleeping bags with mosquito netting.
