### **OVERLOOKED IN TURKEY**

During my recent trip to the Middle East, I had the opportunity to travel to Southern Turkey to visit some of the places damaged by the recent earthquake. Using local connections from Northern Iraq, we visited a town and some small mountain villages that were severely damaged near the epicenter. These places get less help than those in more populated areas. There are no words to express the magnitude of the destruction, pain, and suffering we saw.

The first earthquake happened at 4:17 a.m. as they were asleep. In the mountain villages, they were also dealing with heavy snow that impaired visibility during rescue attempts. Many people died because no one could get to them in time.

The biggest need is for hygiene products and trauma care. Many lost everything as their houses were destroyed. Most have been given a tent and, fortunately, have enough food to eat. We are currently planning a project to distribute hygiene care packages. As we hand these out, it will allow us to visit with people, listen to their stories, and offer encouragement and prayer.

Please be in prayer for the people of Southern Turkey. They are

hurting! Pray that the hygiene project allows us the opportunity to be a piece of their healing process. They were so thankful I came all the way from America to care for them when their own people wouldn't help!
